

Advanced Placement Exams

What Every Student Must Bring to an AP Exam:

Photo ID. You will not be admitted to the exam without a photo ID.

Several sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for completing all multiple-choice answer sheets. Mechanical pencils are not allowed.

Pens with black or dark-blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams

Other items students may bring:

- **A watch** (in case the exam room does not have a clock that can be easily seen)
- **Up to two calculators** with the necessary capabilities if you are taking an AP Biology, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Chemistry, Physics, or Statistics Exam. Visit the most current list of AP-approved calculators on collegeboard.com's student site
- **A ruler or straightedge** if you are taking an AP Physics Exam

What Not to Bring to an Exam:

Electronic devices*: Cell phones, MP3 players, digital cameras, smartwatches or any other electronic or communication devices

Extra materials: Books, compasses, colored pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes

Rulers and straightedges (except students taking the AP Physics Exams)

Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets)

Computers (except as noted for students with disabilities) or calculators (except students taking the AP Biology, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Chemistry, Physics, or Statistics Exams). Visit the most current lists of AP-approved calculators on collegeboard.com's student site

Watches that beep or have an alarm

Portable listening* or recording devices (even with headphones) or photographic equipment

Food or drink**

Clothing with subject-related information

** **Electronic devices are prohibited at the testing facility.** Any student who uses an electronic device in the testing room or during a break will have the device confiscated. He/she will be escorted from the exam site and his/her grades will be cancelled.*

*** **Eating is prohibited while you are taking an exam.** You are allowed to bring a snack and beverage for your 10-minute break. However, snacks or beverages must be stored in a backpack or purse during the exam. If you have two exams on one day, you will be permitted to eat a lunch during general instructions for the second exam.*
