

District Climate Survey

What is it?

The District Climate Survey is a series of questions designed to provide an understanding of how students, parents, and staff feel about schools and the district as a whole.

Why is this assessment given?

As the district works to improve itself, it is important to get feedback from students, staff, and families. This feedback is one of several pieces of evidence that then helps direct improvement efforts at all levels in the district.

Who takes this survey?

The survey is given to students in grades 3 – 12, staff, and parents. There are different versions of the survey in order to make the questions more understandable for specific age groups.

How is the survey given?

The survey is given online at a time scheduled by each building.

When is the survey given?

The survey is given in the month of February. This year, it will be given between Feb. 4 and Feb 22, 2019.

How will results be shared?

The results are shared as building and district results; there are no individual results to share. As such, results will be shared in various ways in district and building documents, but not shared directly with families in a “stand alone” document.

How does this assessment reflect my child's performance?

The District Climate Survey in no way influences your child's academic performance. It represents an opportunity for students, staff and families to provide direct feedback to the district to help drive improvement.
