ACCESS for English Language Learners	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • English Language assessment; State-required for ELLs only • Identifies English proficiency level in reading, writing, speaking, listening • 3 hours, 1 x per year 	<p>12/2 – 1/31</p>
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Advanced Placement (AP)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student choice • 32 test offered across different subjects • Allows students to earn college credit depending on the institution 	<p>5/4 – 5/15</p>
